

I had always encouraged children to be as comfortable as possible during story or circle time in other settings, and I wanted that to continue, but first I asked my nursery staff to put themselves in a child's shoes to see what circle time feels like and to find out whether improvements could be made to make the experience more enjoyable. A third way is to begin by telling a predictable story and then surprise the audience by taking a completely different turn from what was expected. When you invest adequate time for doing storytelling with them, you are instilling virtues they can carry with them as they grow old.
