

Astigmatism usually is caused by the cornea being more curved in one meridian than others. If a patient chooses to have IOLs implanted that correct for distance vision in both eyes, they will most likely need glasses to read. For instance, in patients requiring sedation, it would be necessary to undergo the procedure only once. It may potentially save your life. Surgery to replace the cloudy lens is the only way to improve your eyesight. Your doctor will give you eye drops to dilate your pupil.

The lens is encased in a thin, transparent wrapper called the capsule. For the surgeon, the main benefits of ISBCS involve time and efficiency. Surgery to reposition or exchange an IOL that has dislocated into the vitreous cavity requires concurrent pars plana vitrectomy and carries numerous risks, including postoperative cystoid macular edema and retinal detachment. This will enable your doctor to create a personalized treatment plan, and it reduces the risk of a misplaced lens. Can [eye laser surgery](#) really correct poor vision?

Does this mean the non-laser method is unsafe? No. Aphakic spectacles were therefore not an option when only one eye needed cataract surgery. The capsule also serves as a platform to hold the lens implant. It will remove both the central nucleus and lens cortex. After the capsulotomy, the surgeon now has access to the cataract to remove it. Most people are not aware of the advances in [lasik eye surgery](#) that have taken place in the last couple of years.

In some cases, however, a cataract may be removed without implanting an artificial lens. Let's take a moment to consider how nearsightedness can be treated. Because Medicare and many insurance companies don't cover the cost of the laser-assisted method for all cataract surgeries, it's best to call and find out if the technique would be covered in your case. If the protein cells separate from your eye, they will eventually drift onto the natural lens located behind your pupil. Cataract surgery rarely causes significant pain. Many patients worry that they will see what is happening during the operation.
