The knowledge acquired during the classes helped the students in making thematic objects and models, which were appreciated by a competent jury at the level of the partner schools and at the level of the partnership.

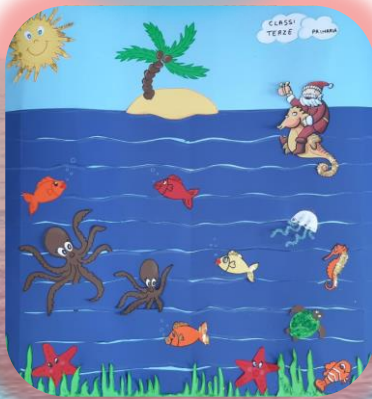

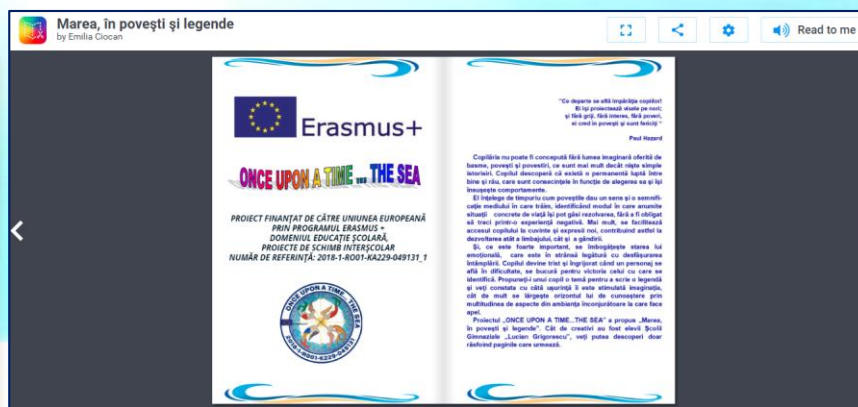
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THE SEA IN STORIES AND LEGENDS

Thus, they watched, from home, documentaries.

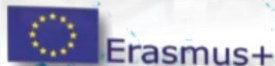

They were very happy when through their involvement, a recipe became a real delicacy!



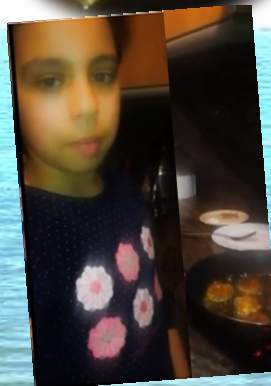
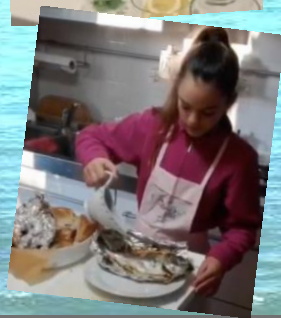
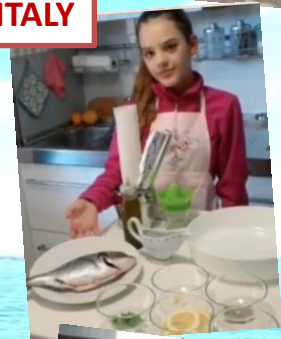
