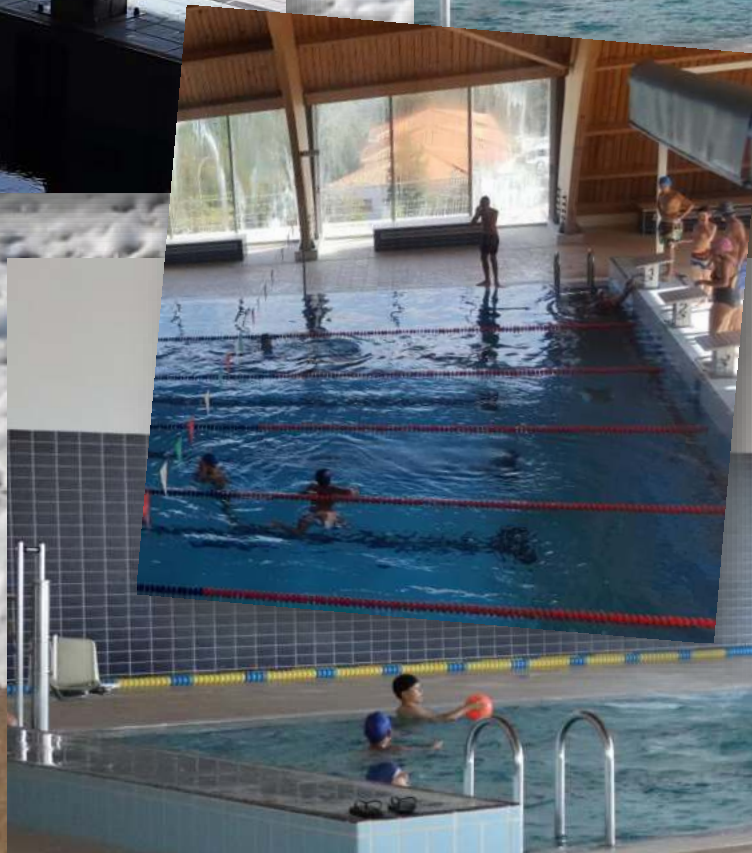

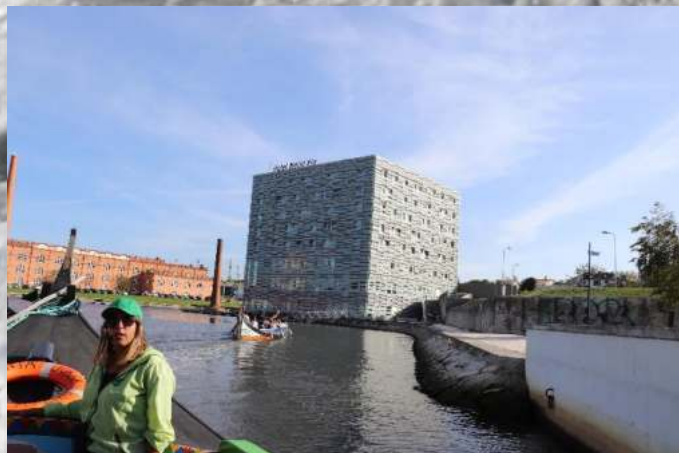


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AVEIRO – PORTUGAL'S VENICE

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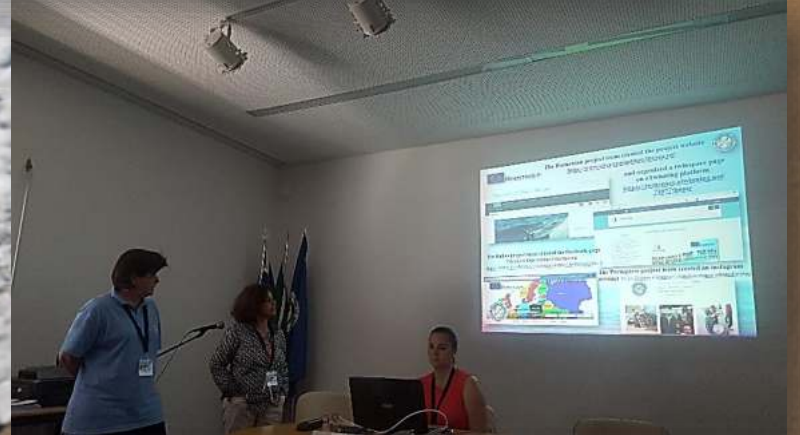
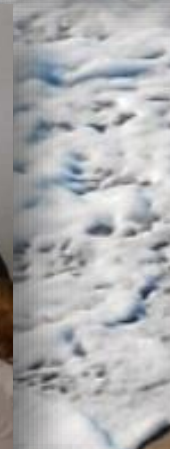


Teachers from all partner institutions presented interesting thematic works in electronic form, that were attractive and interesting for all the persons attending the seminar.

Attracted by the charmed sound of the ocean waves, the participants enjoyed the soft sand of the beach



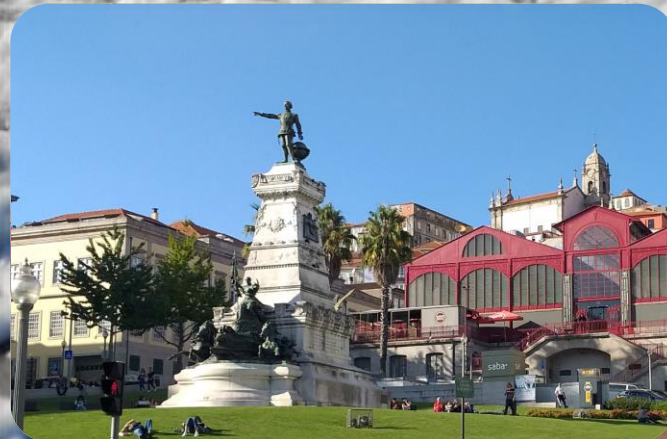
