
(C5) - LTT ACTIVITY REPORT ON SEA WAVES

In a warm and relaxing atmosphere, the participants were informed about the historical, economic and cultural specifics of the area by means of short videos, made with local protagonists. Mayor, Paulo Pereira, stressed the importance of projects with European funding in the formation of active and accountable citizens, who would advocate for a united Europe. At the same time, representatives of the delegations from the partner schools briefly presented the region of provenance and the work carried out during the first year.

All present appreciated the organising manner, friendly working atmosphere, originality and the quality of products.








SURFING LESSONS

Under the guidance of instructors, from a surf school in Porto, students learned the elements and technique of this sport, how to follow the rules of security and climbing on board, the technique of rowing. The theoretical notions were quickly transposed into practice, on the waves of the Atlantic ocean, situation that made the children to declare their joy of practicing surfing, for many of them being the first time.

FORMAL MEETING TO THE CITY HALL






