The students, using different materials and work techniques, made works that represented the diversity and beauty of the marine environment, much appreciated for the originality and ways of approaching the proposed topic.






















Solving a *Kahoot* quiz about the history and culture of the Italian people was an opportunity for students to test or enrich their knowledge in this field.









Due to the facilities offered by digital technology, the participants from the partner schools were directly connected with the interviewees, having the opportunity to find answers to the questions asked and to attend a navigation lesson.

The students formed an image of the sea from a different perspective, that of the refugee crisis on the island of Lampedusa, a small island between the African continent and Sicily, who arrived here crossing the sea by boat, to seek protection for reasons of war and persecution. The children were impressed by the risks to refugees on their way to a better world and by their efforts to find a job, shelter, or health care and education.





The students exchanged information about various objects discovered by archaeologists in the depths of the seas.
















WATCHING THE SHOW TRAVELING WITH ULYSSES

















Issues related to the importance of the seas and oceans, the impact of human activities on marine ecosystems, sustainable fishing, and the protection of marine areas were addressed.




USE OF TELEPHONE AND SOCIAL NETWORKS IN THE TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS




