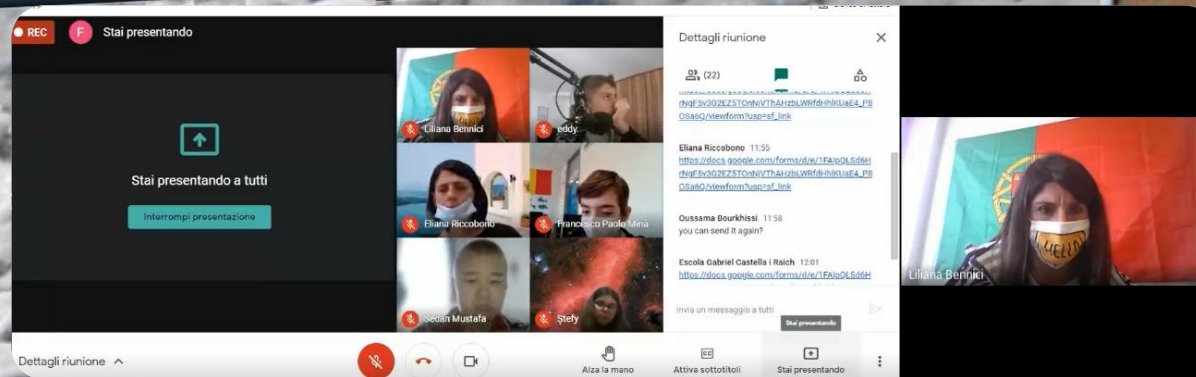




# WATCHING THE DOCUMENTARY FILM *FIRE AT THE SEA (FUOCOAMMARE)*

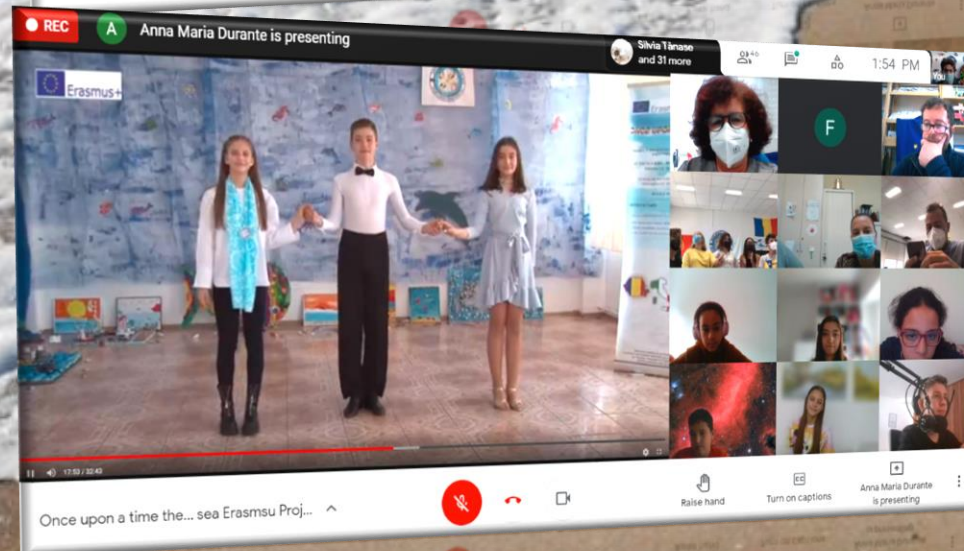






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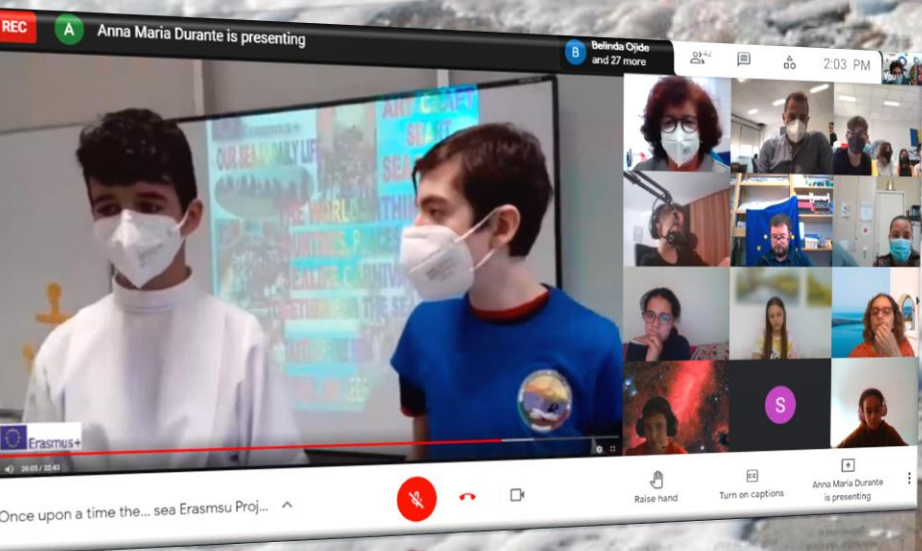
## WATCHING THE SHOW *TRAVELING WITH ULYSSES*
