



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EUROPEAN BLUE SCHOOL CERTIFICATE

Some of the project's activities were designed to be accessible to students with special needs or those from disadvantaged backgrounds. Thus, under the careful guidance of a support teacher and parents, they were able to participate in activities that involved making plastic creations, differentiated learning activities by watching 3D projections about the marine ecosystem, these students had a real chance to learn, to develop creativity and confidence in their own abilities. They learned not only how to express themselves in a multicultural environment, but also how to accept, appreciate, and understand the opinion of others, having the chance to share positive learning experiences together.




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
