"The tournament of two capitals" will be held in turns in the two largest cities of Russia — Moscow and St. Petersburg. In the spring of the participants and guests of the event will take Moscow and the Northern capital will intercept the baton to autumn, in November 2017.

Participants

Participants can be students of Moscow and Saint-Petersburg (including the Moscow and Leningrad regions) grades 5-11 in age from 10 to 18 years.

Competition

T2S consists of five competitions under competition. They, in turn, are divided into two groups on the basis of age:

- Students 10-14 years propose to cope with the tasks of "king of the hill" and "Bridges";
- More adult classes from 14 to 18 years, the organizers prepared other jobs: "Race" and "Swing".

Fifth [programming assignment help](#), the rules would be kept secret until the beginning of the final in Moscow. This task will test the ability of participants to reconfigure their robots in accordance with a new task for a limited time. Robot reassembles don't have.

Awards

- valuable prizes (iPad mini, gyrometer, etc.);
- extra points for the exam (up to 10 points) for admission to the University ITMO;
- stipend of up to 15,000 rubles a month, and a chance to get a student ID card (for applicants 2017).

Qualifying stage in **Saint-Petersburg** appointed to 30 April 2017. On 28 and 29 April the team will be able to come to training and personal consultation to better prepare for the qualifying round. It will be held at the site of the ITMO University (Lomonosova St., 9).

In **Moscow** the qualifying test will be held in mid-April, the organizer of which is the Center of excellence.
